The number one goal of the workshop is to *significantly reduce the opportunity of crime* on your campus. I am also offering, at no charge, an outline of my 13-point School Emergency Evacuation Blueprint. This blueprint is very effective for proactively planning an action strategy to effectively respond to an emergency on campus.

One of the biggest problems with the Virginia Tech shooting emergency was that the students, educators, and shooters were all locked in the same building – with NO way of exiting from the emergency threat. That's a serious lack of planning! Depending on my time allotment, I can also offer a complimentary school safety audit of your campus. I will take a brief tour of the campus and point out any areas that I identify for safety enhancement.
